John Michael Phelps was graduated cum laude from Princeton University with a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1971. He was graduated from the University of California- Hastings College of the Law with a J.D. in 1975. Mr. Phelps has practiced as an attorney in San Francisco, California, for more than thirty years.
