Mrs. Belle D. Eads, 85, Hemlock, died at 9:30 p.m. Friday following an illness of three years. She had been bedfast for 11 months.

She was born March 25, 1876, in Howard County, the daughter of Sidney and Martha (Freeman) Morris. Mrs. Eads had lived
