Harry E. Elson, 62, 1830 S. Bell St., died at 6:45 p.m. Sunday, May 28, 1978, in St. Joseph Memorial Hospital.

Born June 16, 1915 in Kokomo, he was the son of Ernest and Birdie (Brown) Elson. His mother survives.

He had served the U.S. Army as a sergeant during World War II and had been an employee of Chrysler Corp. for 19 years prior to his retirement in 1964. He was also a retiree member of the United Auto Workers Local 685.

Other survivors are three brothers, George and Robert Elson, both of Kokomo, and Adolph Elson of Fountain City; and a sister, Mrs. Leslie Bowen of Spiceland.
